An email will be sent out in advance of the walk asking who is hoping to walk at the weekend, assuming a suitable weather forecast. All walkers need to respond by the end of Thursday to say whether they are wanting to walk. All members are expected to reply, whether or not they are wanting to walk, unless they have opted for a default position that they are not walking. Standardly, an email will be sent on Friday morning detailing the driving/pick up plan. This will not be changed except in extenuating circumstances (e.g. change of destination due to weather forecast). Any other arrangements are by private arrangement only.

If you haven't replied by the end of Thursday deadline, you will be responsible for sorting out transport arrangements for yourself, either by contacting club members or travelling independently.
